Mr. Beck submitted the following amendment:

Strike out the word "five," and insert the word eight.

Which was rejected.

Mr. Baldwin submitted the following amendment:

Strike out the word "five," and insert three.

Which was read.

The vote, by which the amendment submitted by Mr. Beck was adopted, was reconsidered.

The vote then recurring upon the amendment submitted by Mr. Beck, it was rejected.

The question then recurring upon the order submitted by Mr. Gorman, it was adopted.
