

Leave was granted to the Frederick delegation to introduce a bill to repeal the Act of 1867, chapter 250, entitled an Act to add a new section to Article 38, of the Code of Public General Laws relating to "Bailiffs," and re-enact the same with amendments

Leave was granted to the Charles delegation and Mr. Martin to introduce a bill to amend section 140, Article 9, Code of Public Local Laws for Charles county, sub-title "Sheriff."
