A bill entitled an Act appropriating the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars for the repair of that part of the National Road, lying in the State of Maryland, and running from Cumberland to the Pennsylvania line.

The Senate bill entitled an Act to amend section 62, of Article 81, of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the redemption of Real Estate, sold for taxes, as amended by the Act of 1862, chapter 133, with proposed amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Sec. 52, line 9, strike out the word "twenty," and insert in lieu thereof: fifteen.

The amendment was adopted,
