Amend section 3, 6th line, by inserting after the word "the," the word ordinary.

Amend section 8th, 3d line, after the word "ploughs," by inserting the words: and determine the number of hours that shall constitute a day's work, and cause the same to be entered upon the minutes of their proceedings, and to notify the Supervisors thereof in writing.
