

Mr. Webb moved that the leave be referred to the Committee on Wild Fowl.

Decided in the negative.

The question then recurring upon the motion submitted by Mr. Owens,

It was decided in the negative.

Mr. Neill moved that the leave be referred to a committee of three from Cecil, and two from Harford county.

Decided in the negative.

On motion of Mr. Biddle,

The vote by which the motion to refer the leave to the Cecil and Harford delegation was rejected,

Was reconsidered.

The question then recurring upon concurring in the motion submitted by Mr. Owens,

It was decided in the affirmative,

And leave was granted to the Cecil and Harford delegations to report said bill.

On motion of Mr. McCreery,

The House proceeded to the consideration of the bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Western Maryland Extension Railway Company,

Said bill being upon a second reading,

Mr. Hoblitzell moved that the further consideration thereof be postponed and that the bill be printed.

Decided in the negative.

Mr. Neill submitted the following amendment:

Section 11, line 4, after the word "Railway," insert: with power to cross under or over any other railroad.

Which was adopted,

And the bill as amended read a second time,

And ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

On motion of Mr. Chapman, (the rules being suspended,)

Leave was granted to the Committee on Inspections to introduce a bill to amend chapter 148, of Act passed at January session, 1867, relating to the repayment of storage and out-
age on tobacco to persons entitled thereto.
