Mr. Miller presented the petition of John S. McClurg, J. Alfred Ritter, Ezra Houck and one hundred others, praying the Legislature to repeal Article XI., Code of Local Laws for Frederick county, sub-title "Almshouse," and re-enact the same with amendments.

Which was read, and referred to the Select Committee on that subject.

Mr. Langrell presented the petition of H. D. Larmore, requesting an Act to be passed allowing him (a minor) to receive from his guardian property inherited from Reuben Larmore.
