The following Acts having passed both Branches of the General Assembly, were this day submitted to His Excellency, the Governor, for his approval :

An Act to prevent swine from running at large in the streets, lanes and alleys contiguous to Burkittsville, in Frederick county.

Also,

An Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Charles county, to review and correct the valuation of the lands in said county, assed to Elizabeth M. Mathews.

Also,

An Act to amend the Act incorporating the Western Maryland Railroad Company, and to give additional powers to said Company.

Also,

An Act to direct the Comptroller to issue his warrant to the Treasurer, to pay to Luther Giddings, the sum of twenty-four hundred and ninety-five dollars, for printing, binding and distributing the Report of the Board of State School Commissioners for the year 1870.

Also,

An Act to add additional sections to Article XI., of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Frederick County," requiring certain duties of the County Commissioners and County Collector of said county, in regard to any sum or sums of money which is or shall be appropriated for the use of any person or persons in said county, and not paid over to such person or persons during the term of office of said County Collector, said section to come in after section 349, and to be section 350, of said Article.
