James Dolan, deceased, to the Young Catholics' Friend Society of the City of Baltimore, for the purpose of establishing a Children's Aid Society, and to incorporate the Board of Managers of the Dolan's Children's Aid Society, under the charge of the Young Catholics' Friend Society.
