The bill entitled an Act to repeal chapter 182, of the Act passed at the January Session of the General Assembly of Maryland, 1870, which was an Act to repeal chapter 414, of the Acts of 1868, which was an Act to repeal Article LXIII, of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to Militia, and sections 652 to 770, both inclusive, of Article IV, of the City of Baltimore, relating to Militia, and to enact the following in lieu thereof,
