Mr. Chapman submitted the following amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Line 11, after the words "setting forth," strike out all to the end of the section, and insert the following: "That the said pensioner is in indigent circumstances, and also the affidavit of two respectable witnesses to the fact that the said pensioner or the person for whose services the said pension is claimed, was a soldier in the war of 1812, and that the said pensioner is now in indigent circumstances, that he or she is a bona-fide resident of the State, and was at the time said service was rendered, and a certificate from the Circuit Court of the county or one of the Courts of Baltimore City, as the case may be, to the fact of the credibility of the said witnesses."

Which was adopted.

Mr. Griswold submitted the following amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

"That the Comptroller shall audit and adjust the amount of pension for all the pensioners herein named from January 1st 1870, who have not received the same by reason of misspelling of names heretofore."
