The bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 of Article IV., of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Aliens," and to re-enact the following in lieu thereof, authorizing aliens to hold and dispose of real estate,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to repeal section 2, of the Act of 1870, chapter 79, incorporating the town of Frostburg, in Allegany county, and to re-enact the same with amendments,
