The Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 8, of an Act passed at January Session, 1870, chapter 325, entitled an Act to amend Article LXXXI. of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Revenue and Taxes," by adding sections 5, 6, 7 and 8, to section 34, of Article LXXXI., and relating to the appointment of Collectors and collection of taxes, so far as said section 8 relates to Washington county, and to extend the provisions of the said Act of 1870, chapter 325, to Washington county,
