The Secretary of the Senate returned

The Senate bill entitled an Act to provide for the introduction of a supply of water into the town of Hagerstown by means of water works, appointing a Water Board for that purpose, and authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Hagerstown to provide for the construction of said works.

Endorsed, "Reconsidered, Report of Conference Committee adopted, bill passed by yeas and nays with amendments proposed by the Committee of Conference."

The amendments as proposed by following Report of Committee of Conference :

REPORT.

The undersigned, the Committee of Conference, appointed to consider the disagreeing votes of the two Houses on the Senate bill entitled an Act for the introduction of a supply of water into the town of Hagerstown, by the means of water works, appointing a Water Board for that purpose, and authorizing the Mayor and Council of Hagerstown to provide means for the construction of said works, respectfully report, that they have carefully considered the same, and recommend for the adoption of their respective bodies the following amendments :

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

In the first line of the title of the bill, insert the word "soft," before the word "water."

In the third line of section 1, insert the word "soft," before the word "water."

At the end of the 9th section, insert the following words : "And the amount of money so to be expended, shall be designated and appropriated only by and with the advice and consent of the said Water Board, or a majority of them, it being the meaning of this Act that the water to be supplied to the said town of Hagerstown shall be soft water."
