

“To Daniel M. Thomas, for services as Auditor in said cases, the sum of five hundred dollars.”

Under head “Militia:”

Provided, that no part of the said appropriation shall be paid for Clerk hire.

In line 20, section 15, Home of the Friendless Children in Easton, Talbot county, “two thousand dollars.”

Which were severally read.

Also, returned,

The bill entitled an Act making further appropriations for the support of the Government, for the year ending the 31st day of December 1873.

To St. Mary's Industrial School, five thousand dollars.

To the Shelter for Colored Orphans, four hundred dollars.

To St. Anthony's Orphan Asylum, four hundred dollars.

To St. Vincent's Orphan Asylum, four hundred dollars.

To St. Mary's Orphan Asylum, four hundred dollars.

To the Union Orphan Asylum, four hundred dollars.

To the Manual Labor School, four hundred dollars.

To the Boys' Home, five hundred dollars.
