AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Add to title the words "hereinafter mentioned." Strike out balance of preamble after word "security," in line 23, page 2. Strike out balance of section 2, after the word "bonds," in line 14, page 3.

Strike out all of section 4, after the word "payment," in line 9, page 4, and insert "as aforesaid."

Strike out sections 5 and 6 ; make section 7 section 5 ; add as section 6:

And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.
