Was read a second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill, entitled an Act to authorize and empower the Boards of County Commissioners of Baltimore and Harford counties, at the joint expense of said counties, to build a bridge over the Little Gunpowder river, at or near Joshua R. Green's ford,

Was read a third time, and passed by yeas and nays, as follows:
