The bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Farmers', Merchants' and Mechanics' Association of the State of Maryland.

The bill entitled an Act to declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland, to the bequest of John Coates, late of Baltimore City, deceased, to the Sabbath School attached to the Methodist Protestant Church, at the corner of Lombard and Green streets, in the City of Baltimore.

The bill entitled an Act to create an additional Election District in Prince George's county, to be styled the Eleventh Election District of Prince George's county.

The bill entitled an Act to create a loan to provide for the payment of the overdue debt of the State, and issuing a currency loan in lieu thereof.

Endorsed, "Passed by yeas and nays."

The bill entitled an Act to appropriate the sum of ten thousand dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, to repair the State Tobacco Warehouses in Baltimore City.

The bill entitled an Act to authorize the Elkton and Elk Valley Railroad Company, to charge a higher rate for transportation and tolls of persons and freight than is permitted by section 13, of chapter 276, of the Acts of 1870, codified as section 224, of Article XXVI., of the amended Code of Public General Laws, title "Corporations," sub-title "Railroads," under which Article said company is incorporated.
