

Leave was granted to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings to prepare and report a bill to repeal section 6 of Article XXIX. of the Code of Public General Laws entitled "Courts," and re-enact the same with amendments.

Leave was granted to the Committee on Finance to prepare and report a bill to provide for the distribution among the tobacco growing counties of the net revenues arising from the inspectors of tobacco.

Mr. Deuson, from a Select Committee to which leave had been granted, reported a bill, entitled an Act to further amend the charter of the Baltimore Fell's Point Hebrew Friendship congregation in the city of Baltimore.
