Be referred to the Committee on Chesapeake Bay and its Tributaries,

And that part relating to

"Wild Fowl,"

To a Special Committee of seven.

So much thereof as is embraced under the head of "Insurance,"

Be referred to the Committee on Finance.

So much thereof as is embraced under the head of "Vaccination,"

Be referred to a Special Committee of five members.

So much thereof as is embraced under the head of the "Case of Daniel Nye, of Maryland, &c.,"

Be referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.

So much thereof as is embraced under the head of

"Apportionment of Delegates to the General Assembly,"

Be referred to a Special Committee of five members.
