Corcoran, in the Courts of the District of Columbia, against the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company, with a copy of the rules of practice of said Courts; also a certified copy of all action that has been taken by the President and Directors of the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company relating to said suit; a certified copy of the answer filed or to be filed by the Canal Company in said suit; the names and residence of the counsel employed, or to be employed by the Canal Company to defend said suit; the compensation to be paid counsel, with a copy of all papers or action taken relating in any way to said suit by the President and Directors of said Canal Company.
