Stephenson, Denson and Henry to report a bill to repeal chapter 418, passed at January Session 1870, entitled an Act to repeal all those sections of Article IV. of the Code of Public Local Laws, for the City of Baltimore, title "Inspections," from section 272 to section 567, &c., and to re-enact such acts and supplemental acts, and sections thereby repealed.
