

Senate bill, entitled an Act for the repair and improvement of the public roads in Calvert county,

Was taken up, when

Mr. Williams offered the following amendment:

Strike out section 8, and insert in lieu thereof:

Section 8. And be it enacted, that chapter two hundred and ninety-nine of the Act of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, entitled an Act to repeal the Act of eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, chapter two hundred and ninety, entitled an Act to add a new Article to the Code of Public General Laws, to be entitled "Public Roads," except so far as said Act relates to Somerset county, and to enact the following section in lieu thereof, be and the same is hereby repealed in so far as the same applies to Calvert county.

Which was adopted.

The bill, as amended, was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Senate bill, entitled an Act to repeal sections 170, 171 and 172, of Article I. of the Code of Local Laws, under the head of Allegany county, relating to weights and measures,

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Senate bill, entitled an Act directing the County Commissioners of Washington county to issue bonds to raise money to build a Court House in said county, and appointing Commissioners to contract to erect the same,

Was read the third time and passed by yeas and nays as follows:
