Senate bill, entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay Thomas J. Twilley, tax collector for Sharpstown district, in Wicomico County, for overpayment into the Treasury for the years 1863 and 1869,

Was read the second time and referred to the Committee on Finance.

Mr. Earle, from the Committee on Finance, reported a bill, entitled an Act to exempt from city and State taxation the real and personal property of the Improved Order of Red Men, of Baltimore City.

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Steiner submitted the third annual report of the Maryland Institution for the Education of the Deaf and Dumb.

Which was referred to the Committee on Education.
