Said bill was then returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Steiner presented the petition of three hundred and thirty-five citizens of Frederick County, (one hundred and seventeen of whom are females), praying the passage of a general law to enable the qualified voters of any Ward in any City, or Election District in any County, within the State, to determine by ballot whether drinking houses may or may not be licensed, within said ward or district, under existing law; and in all wards or election districts voting against such license, to prohibit the sale of such drinks, (except for medicinal purposes), and provide for the same a penalty.

Which was read, and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.

On motion by Mr. Denson,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Finance to introduce a bill, to amend the Act of January Session, 1852, chapter 328, entitled "An Act relating to tolls to be charged by the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company on the Washington branch of the said road," by providing that the said Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company shall, upon the com-
