BY THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES,

February 9, 1872.

*Gentlemen of the Senate:*

We respectfully propose, with the concurrence of your Honorable Body, the appointment of a Joint Committee of the two Houses, to consist of three on the part of the House and two on the part of the Senate, to confer upon the unfavorable report of your Honorable Body on the bill, entitled an Act to amend section 1, chapter 473, of the Acts of 1870, entitled an Act to add an additional section to Article IV. of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Police," and be section 827 of said Article, by providing that jurisdiction in cases where concealed weapons
