February 13, 1872.

*Gentlemen of the Senate :*

We have received your message, proposing, with the concurrence of this House, the appointment of a Joint Committee of the two Houses, four from the House of Delegates and three from the Senate, to carry into effect the requirement of section 45, of Article CXI. of the Constitution, relating to providing a simple and uniform system of charges in the offices of Clerks of Courts and Registers' of Wills in the counties of this State and the City of Baltimore, and the collection thereof, and concur therein.
