EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT,
Annapolis, February 16th, 1872.

Gentlemen of the Senate :

I have approved and signed the following bill, received from your Honorable Body, and have transmitted the same to the Clerk of the Court of Appeals, in accordance with the Constitution :

An Act supplemental to the Act of 1870, chapter 58, entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Frederick county to build a new Alms-house for Frederick county; to borrow money on the credit of the county for that purpose; to issue bonds for the payment of the same; and to levy taxes on the assessable property of said county to redeem said bonds, and to pay the interest thereon.
