A bill, entitled an Act to authorize the Town Commissioners of Newtown, to endorse the bonds of the Worcester and Somerset Railroad Company, to the amount of \$5,000.

The following Senate bills having passed both branches of the General Assembly of Maryland, were this day presented to his Excellency, the Governor, for his approval.

An Act to authorize the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Cumberland to issue bonds for the purpose of providing for the payment of the debts, other than bonded of said City, and for the extension of water mains throughout the portions of said City not yet provided therewith.

An Act to repeal an Act passed January Session, 1870, chapter 11, entitled an Act to repeal section 204, of Article XXI., of the Code of Public Local Laws for Washington county, relating to Justices of the Peace and Constables in said county, and to amend and re-enact said section 204, Article XXI. of the said Code, to read as follows.
