The Senate bill, entitled an Act to repeal section 10 of Article XXXVII. of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the pay of witnesses attending the Circuit Courts or Orphans' Courts of this State, and re-enact the same as amended,

Being upon a third reading,

Mr. Steiner submitted the following amdndment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Amend by striking out "Frederick" where it occurs in said bill.
