On motion by Mr. Carroll,

Was referred to the Committee on Finance.

On motion by Mr. Henry,

Leave was granted to Messrs. Fields and Denson, to introduce a bill to authorize the County Commissioners of Dorchester county to aid in the construction and completion of the Vienna Railroad.

On motion by Mr. Jump,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Judiciary Proceedings, to report a bill to repeal section 47, Article XVIII., of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Clerks of Courts," so far as relates to Talbot county, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

On motion by Wilson,

Leave was granted to Messrs. Wilson, Longwell and Blake, to report a bill to regulate the pay of State's Attorney for Prince George's county.

On motion by Mr. Blake,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Finance, to report a bill to incorporate the Real Estate Bank of Baltimore.

Mr. Jump, from a Select Committee, to which had been referred the petitions of numerous citizens of Talbot county, praying the passage of a law forming an additional election district in said county.

Reported unfavorably thereon, and the report was adopted.

Mr. Tuck, from the Committee on Judicial Proceedings, to which leave had been granted, reported

A bill entitled an Act to provide for the defense of Officers of Registration, Judges of Election, and others, who are indicted for alleged violations of the Acts of Congress enforcing the right of citizenship in the United States.

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Wilson, from a Select Committee, to which had been referred

The House bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Prince George's county to build a bridge,

Reported favorably thereon, and

Said bill was read the second time.
