

Senate bill, entitled an Act to repeal section 47, Article XVIII. of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Clerks of Courts," so far as the same applies to Talbot county, and to re-enact the same with amendments,

Being upon its second reading,

Mr. Jump submitted the following amendments:

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Section 1, line 3, after word "County," insert "entitled Clerks of Courts."

Add additional section:

Section 3. Be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Which were adopted.

Said bill, as amended, was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Tuck presented the petition of Francis Denmead and others, asking an amendment of bill relating to "advance mortgages,"
