Referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.

Also, from a Select Committee to which leave had been granted, reported

A bill, entitled an Act to repeal Article LXXXVII. of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Sheep," and to reenact the same with amendments.

Which was read the first time.

On motion by Mr. Earle,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings to report a bill, entitled an Act to amend an Act passed January Session, 1870, chapter 441, by repealing and re-enacting the same, relating to fees and accounts of county officers.

Mr. Dawis, from a Select Committee, to which had been referred

The House bill, entitled an Act to make valid the action of the Local Board of Road Supervisors in Baltimore county, reported favorably thereon.

Said bill was then read the second time.
