The Senate bill, entitled an Act to repeal section 872, of Article IV., of the Public Local Laws, relating to the City of Baltimore, entitled an Act to authorize the extension of the limits of the direct taxation within the City of Baltimore, be and the same are hereby repealed, and the following reenacted in lieu thereof.
