The House bill, entitled an Act to amend and re-enact the Laws regulating the taking and catching of Oysters with Rakes or Tongs.

Said bill was then read the second time.

The House bill, entitled an Act to repeal chapter 129, of the Laws passed January Session, 1870, and to re-enact the same with amendments relating to the taking of Oysters with Scoops, in the waters of Fishing Bay and Honga river, in Dorchester county,
