On motion by Mr. Dennis,

Leave was granted to Messrs. Dennis, Sellman and Williams to introduce a bill, entitled an Act to change the name of Potato Neck Election District to Fairmount Election District,

On motion by Mr. Davis,

The vote by which the Senate passed the House bill, making valid the action of certain Road Supervisors for Baltimore county,

Was reconsidered, and

Said bill was postponed.

Mr. Steiner, from a Select Committee, to which had been referred,

The House bill, entitled an Act for the better protection of birds in Frederick county,

Reported said bill with the following amendments:

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Strike out all after the enacting clause, and insert the following sections:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person, at any time, to shoot, or otherwise to kill or injure, or pursue with such intent any of the following named birds within the limits of Frederick county, viz: Robins, bluebirds, thrushes, martins, swallows, larks, orioles, redbirds, catbirds, sparrows, whippoorwills, wrens, peewits, gold finches, sapsuckers or woodpeckers; provided, that nothing contained in this Act shall be so constructed as to prevent the killing or capture of crows, blackbirds or birds of prey.

Section 2. And be it enacted, That it shall be unlawful for any person, knowingly and unnecessarily to destroy or dis-
