AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

After the first section insert the following:

Section 2, *And be it enacted*, That the Town Commissioners of Towsontown shall turn over and deliver to the County Commissioners of Baltimore county all books and papers in their possession relating to the affairs of the said town, and a full list and statement of all taxes that have been levied and collected by the said Town Commissioners from the time of the first organization of the said town under its charter to the date of the repeal thereof, and all money and all property of every kind in their possession, and the said County
