The House bill, entitled an Act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from the City of Westminster, to Bird Hill, in Carroll county.

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Steiner, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

The House bill, entitled an Act to divide Election District Number Two, in Frederick county, into four polls, and to repeal an Act passed by the General Assembly of Maryland on the first day of February, in the year 1862, chapter 53, entitled an Act to divide Election District Number Two, in Frederick county, into two polls.

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Fields called up House bill, entitled an Act to incorporate the Butchers' and Drovers' Bank of Baltimore.
