

The House bill, entitled an Act to enable the Judges of the Circuit Court of Somerset county to make certain recommendations.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Dennis, Williams and Sellman.

The House bill, entitled an Act to repeal sections 133, 134, 135, 136, 137, 138, 139, 140, 141, 142, 143, 144, 145 and 146, of Article X., of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester County," sub-title "East New-Market, and re-enact the same with amendments, and to add sub-sections thereto, to come in after section 146.
