The following Act, having passed both branches of the General Assembly, was this day submitted to his Excellency, the Governor, for his approval :

An Act to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to issue and lend to the Western Maryland Railroad Company the stock of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to the amount of one million of dollars, redeemable on the first day of January, 1902, and bearing interest at the rate of six per centum per annum from the first day of January, 1872, to aid in the construction of the railroad of the said company.

GENTLEMEN—I have this day signed and approved the following bill received from your Honorable Body, and transmitted the same to the Clerk of the Court of Appeals, in accordance with the provisions of section 17, Article II., and section 30, Article III., of the Constitution, viz :

An Act to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to issue and lend to the Western Maryland Railroad Company the stock of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to the amount of one million of dollars, redeemable on the first day of January, 1902, and bearing interest at the rate of six per centum per annum from the first day of January, 1872, to aid in the construction of the railroad of the said company.
