The bill to repeal section 16, of Article II., of the Code of Public General Laws, "title Justices of the Peace.

And the report was adopted.

The Senate concurred in the House amendments, to the bill relating to the County Commissioners of Calvert county, subscribing to the capital stock of the Baltimore and Drum Point Railroad Company.
