

Orphan Asylum, four hundred dollars; to St. Vincent's Orphan Asylum, four hundred dollars; to the German Orphan Asylum, four hundred dollars; to St. Mary's Orphan Asylum, four hundred dollars; to the Union Orphan Asylum, four hundred dollars; to the Manual Labor School, four hundred dollars; to the Boys' Home, five hundred dollars, to the Church Home and Infirmary, three thousand dollars; to the House of the Friendless Children, in Easton, Talbot county, one thousand dollars."

Mr. Blake submitted the following amendment to the amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Strike out the words: "To the Rev. Edward Brennan, to the use of the St. Edward's Academy, in the City of Cumberland, to be applied to the support and education of free schools of said Academy, the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars."
