Election of directors.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That in the election of directors on the part of the private stockholders the stock of the State shall not be voted, nor shall the same be counted in ascertaining the presence of a quorum necessary for such election, but the Board of Public Works shall be empowered to appoint two directors of said company on the part of the State.
