Board of Trustees has taken place for more than one year, whereby all of the aforesaid Trustees have vacated their office and have become incapable of acting as such under the Act aforesaid, therefore,

Trustees appointed.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That John S. Purnell, Robert J. Henry, John E. H. Marshall, Hillary R. Pitts, William D. Pitts, Cyrus L. Williams, Littleton D. Powell, John R. Purnell, John T. Hammond, Levin L. Derrickson, and Zadock P. Henry, and their successors, are hereby constituted and appointed Trustees of Buckingham Academy and Berlin Female Seminary, aforesaid, and all the property, real, personal or mixed, and all the rights, privileges, franchises and credits, of whatever description, which appertained or belonged to the aforesaid Board of Trustees, at the time they ceased to hold said office, on account of their failure to hold meetings of said Board, are hereby vested in them as such Trustees; as fully as if no such failure or neglect to hold said meetings had ever taken place.

CHAPTER 20.

AN ACT to make valid the sale and transfer by the Union Bridge Turnpike Company to the Liberty Johnsville and Pipe Creek Turnpike Road Company, of all that part of the road of said Union Bridge Turnpike Company, from Union Bridge, Carroll county, Maryland, to Daniel Wolf's in Frederick county, and to vest the franchises of said Union Bridge Turnpike Company, or said part of said Turnpike Road, in the Liberty Johnsville and Pipe Creek Turnpike Road Company.
