

Altered and amended.    SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the powers contained in the first section of said Act be and the same are hereby altered and amended so as to read: *Provided*, that the value of real estate held at any time by the said corporation, shall not exceed one hundred thousand dollars.

Alter, amend or annul.    SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the Legislature reserves to itself the right to alter, amend or annul this Act at its pleasure.

In force.    SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 30.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and twenty-six of the Laws, passed January session eighteen hundred and seventy, entitled "An Act to authorize the Faculty and Board of Trustees of the Washington University of Baltimore, to use the real estate of said University, situated at the corner of Calvert and Saratoga streets in Baltimore city, as a basis of credit to raise a sum of money not exceeding ten thousand dollars, by creating a ground rent thereon, for the uses of said University.

Preamble.    WHEREAS, By reason of the misnomer of the corporate title of the Board of Visitors of the Washington University of Baltimore, in the Act above referred to, the purposes of said Act failed to be accomplished; *and, whereas*, the necessities of the said Washington University of Baltimore, and the hospital connected therewith, require a larger sum of money to defray the expenses of the buildings than was originally contemplated.

Section repealed.    SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section one, of chapter one hundred twenty-six of the Laws, passed January session, eighteen hundred and seventy, be and the same is
