

The bill, entitled an Act to repeal section 18 of Article LVI. of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Licenses," sub-title "Fisheries and Horse Races," and to re-enact the same so as to read as follows,

Reported the same favorably.

A bill, entitled an Act to add an additional section to the Public Local Laws of Allegany county, Article I., Allegany county, and to repeal sections 24, 25 and 26 thereof, and re-enact the same with amendments, to read as follows.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

Also,

A bill, entitled an Act to change the dividing line between the first and eighth election districts of Worcester county.

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Worcester delegation, and Mr. Langrell, of Wicomico.

The bill, entitled an Act to authorize Louisa M. Rial to settle her account as guardian to Albert Rial, and deliver over the estate to said ward,
