

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That no person shall shoot <sup>Not to shoot</sup> or kill, or shoot at any wild-fowl in, on, or over the <sup>or kill at</sup> waters lying northward of the line described in section one of this Act, in the night time with gun or guns, of any size or description whatever, and any person violating the provisions of this section, upon conviction thereof, shall be subject to a fine of not less than one hundred dollars and not more than <sup>Penalty.</sup> five hundred dollars, for each and every violation thereof.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That no person shall at <sup>Within half a</sup> any time, either in the day or night time, shoot or <sup>mile.</sup> kill, or shoot at any wild-fowl in, on, or over the waters lying northward of the line described in the first section of this Act, from any vessel, boat, float, canoe, sneak-boat, sink-boat or any other craft of any kind or description whatever, within half a mile of any shore in Harford or Cecil county, and any person violating this section, shall, on conviction thereof, be subject to a penalty for each offence of not less than fifty dollars, and not more than one hundred <sup>Penalty.</sup> dollars.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That no person shall kill, <sup>Big gun or</sup> or shoot at wild water-fowl in, on, or over the waters of <sup>swivel.</sup> the Chesapeake Bay from any boat, box, or vessel of any kind or description whatever, with any big or swivel gun, or any kind of gun which cannot be conveniently discharged from the shoulder at arms-length, and without a rest, and any person violating this section, on conviction thereof, shall pay a fine of not <sup>Penalty.</sup> not less than one hundred dollars, nor more than five hundred dollars for each offence.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That no person shall gun <sup>Days on</sup> for or after wild water-fowl, or shoot at or kill the <sup>which may</sup> same, northward of the line named and described in the first section of this Act, but three days in each week during the season for shooting wild-fowl as fixed by the second section of this Act, and those days shall be Monday, Wednesday and Friday, and each of said days shall comprehend the time intervening between one hour before sunrise A. M., and half an hour after sunset P. M., of each day and no more, and is not to include any part or period of
