#### CHAPTER 58.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments, chapter forty-four of the Act of eighteen hundred and seventy, entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, section one hundred and seventy, article thirty, Public General Laws, entitled "Crime and Punishments," sub-title "Rivers."

Repealed.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That chapter forty-four, of the Acts of eighteen hundred and seventy, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

Re-enacted.

170. If any ballast, ashes, filth, earth, soil, oysters or oyster shells, be taken, unladen or cast out of any ship, steamboat, scow, pungy or other vessel, on any pretence whatever, in the Chesapeake Bay, above "Sandy Point," or in the waters of Herring Bay, or in any river, creek or harbor, within this State, below high water mark; the master, or other person having charge or command of such ship, steamboat, scow or other vessel, shall, upon conviction thereof
