CHAPTER 68.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Charles county, to review and correct the valuation of the lands, in said county, assessed to Elizabeth E. Mathews and W. W. Dunnington.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Charles county, be and they are hereby authorized to review the assessment and valuation of the lands of Elizabeth E. Mathews and W. W. Dunnington, situated in said county, and to correct and reduce such assessment, if satisfied that the said lands, or any of them, are erroneously assessed.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its approval by the Governor.
