SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take In force. effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 85.

AN ACT to direct the Comptroller to issue his warrant to the Treasurer to pay to Luther Giddings the sum of twenty-four hundred and ninety-five dollars for printing, binding, and distributing the report of the Board of State School Commissioners, for the year eighteen hundred and seventy.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller of the Treasury be directed to issue warrant to the Treasurer to pay to Luther Giddings the sum of twenty-four hundred and nine-five dollars, which said sum is in full for furnishing paper, printing, binding and distributing three thousand copies of the report of the Board of State School Commissioners, for the year eighteen hundred and seventy, by order of the Governor, in accordance with the Act of eighteen hundred and seventy, providing for a system of Free Public Schools, chapter three hundred and eleven, sub-chapter twelve, section eleven.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take In force. effect from and after the day of its passage.
