## CHAPTER 104.

AN ACT to allow an additional clerk in the office of Treasurer of this State.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Employ addi-Maryland, That the Treasurer of the State be and he tional clerk, is hereby authorized to employ an additional clerk, at a salary of twelve hundred dollars per annum.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take In force effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 105.

AN ACT to authorize the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Montgomery county, to place certain fees in the hands of the Sheriffs of the several counties of this State and the City of Baltimore, for collection.

Whereas, E. B. Prettyman, Clerk of the Circuit Preamtle. Court for Montgomery county, has failed to place his fees since June term, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, of said Court, in the hands of the Sheriffs of the several counties of this State and the City of Baltimore, for collection; therefore

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Sheriffs to Maryland, That all fees due E. B. Prettyman, Clerk collect fees of the Circuit Court for Montgomery county, which due E. B Prettyman. have occurred since June term, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, of said Court, shall be received and collected by the Sheriffs of the several counties of this State and of the City of Baltimore, in the same manner as fees due such officers have been heretofore collected, and such Sheriffs shall use and have the Enforce paysame means of enforcing payment of, and collecting ment.
